



Environmental Education Program Things to Know Before You Go!

Waivers

Please arrive 10 minutes before the start of your program. During check-in City of Pleasanton staff will ask for your signed waivers.

Chaperones

City of Pleasanton requires a ratio of at least one adult per eight students. Younger siblings are not permitted on field trips. We ask that teachers and chaperones oversee student behavior during the program and keep cell phones turned off.

Weather & What to Bring

Aside from Adobe Chores our field trips happen rain or shine. It is up to the teacher to decide if they would like to cancel due to rain. If you would like to reschedule a field trip call our Environmental Education office at (925) 931-3479.

All of our programs are outdoors so please make sure that your students are dressed appropriately for the weather. On warm days your students should have water bottles, sunscreen, and hats. On rainy days they should wear a rain jacket, layered clothing, and potentially bring a change of shoes and socks.

Park Information

All of the parks where we host field trips have bathrooms, water fountains, and picnic tables. Please note however that Alviso Adobe does not have any grass areas.

Alviso Adobe Community Park: 3465 Old Foothill Rd. Pleasanton

Alviso Adobe has 20 parking spaces for field trips arriving by carpool and a turnout for school buses. There are no public bus stops near the park.

Augustin Bernal Park: 8200 Golden Eagle Way, Pleasanton

To reach this park take Foothill Rd to Golden Eagles Estates. Be prepared to show proof of Pleasanton residence to the guard. Take the Golden Eagle Estates road all the way to the top where it widens into a parking lot. Please obey all traffic laws and the speed limit while in Golden Eagle Estates.
